**Time Commitment:** The Trustee Board currently meets 4 times per year (January, April, June, October), usually in the evenings for about 2 ½ hours. If work / family commitments allow, a trustee is linked with one of our venues so he/she can visit, see the foodbank in action and build relationships with some of our volunteers.

We are also seeking a new chair of trustees, who may be appointed from our current trustees or could be a new trustee if someone applies who has the relevant skills, enthusiasm and experience.
