I believe that there is no such thing as a perfect church or a perfect Christian, so we are all inevitably going to disagree with something that either St Wilfrid's does, or the C of E does. I hope that when you put your finger on those things, you will let me know. I also hope you will have other people to talk and pray through those issues with. Who are they?
