I hope you are enjoying our journey through Ruth. This week Kim looked at Ruth 3. She has this for us:

There are multiple, sometimes conflicting, commentaries about this passage, mostly filling in the gaps about what is *not* written, rather than understanding what is written in cultural context. This is not helped by the sometimes differing translations of the text. If you have access to different versions of the bible, it is worth reading the passage again to see where things are emphasised or subtle nuances might change your understanding.

Try accessing some Jewish teaching on the book of Ruth on line – Rabbinical studies have expanded on the text and give cultural context.
